- 1. Go to the SCC main website: www.shoreline.edu
- 2. Click on: Current Students (on left side of page)
- 3. Email
- 4. Look up my email user name and password
- 5. Enter your Student Identification # (SID) in blank box. (If you don't know it, ask your instructor)
- 6. Enter your PIN # (This is your birthdate, 6 digits, no spaces or hyphens)
- 7. Continue
- 8. Reset password
- 9. Create password
- 10. Log into account to initiate account
